WHY THIS CONFERENCE?

According to Kentucky Department for Public Health statistics:

1. In Kentucky, the AIDS diagnosis rate for African Americans/Blacks was approximately 8 times higher than the rate for Whites from 2003 to 2007.
2. African Americans/Blacks comprised 7.7% of the 2007 Kentucky population, yet accounted for 38% of new HIV cases diagnosed in that year. Hence, the proportion of new HIV cases among Blacks was over four times that of their general representation in the population.
3. Hispanics comprised 2.2% of Kentucky’s population, but accounted for 8% of new HIV cases diagnosed in 2007. Hence, the proportion of new HIV cases among Hispanics was over three times that of their general representation in the population.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This conference is designed for anyone interested in stopping the spread of HIV/AIDS in the African American and Hispanic Communities. Health care and social service professionals who are involved in planning and/or providing direct delivery of services to African American or Hispanic persons living with HIV/AIDS in Kentucky, as well as persons who are interested in improving the quality of life for people living with HIV/AIDS. Leaders of all segments of the community are asked to attend to get information and the knowledge to mobilize their communities to help stop the spread of HIV/AIDS.
